




**Venue: The Hall, St. Margaret's House, 21, Old Ford Road, Bethnal Green E2 9PL**

Entrance to the Hall is through the archway and double gates between 17-19 Old Ford Road

**Underground:** From Bethnal Green Underground Station (Central Line), take the Museum of Childhood exit. Walk along Museum frontage to the first corner which is Old Ford Road. Turn right into Old Ford Road and 17-19 is on the other side of the road, just past York Hall.



**Buses:** Nos. 8 - 106 - 254 - 309 - 388 - D3 and D6.
